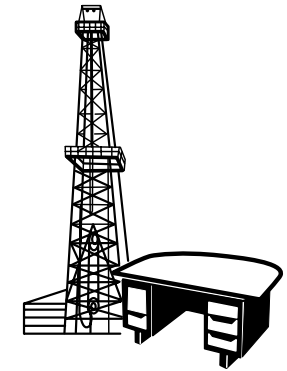

For more than 50 years, ADDC has maintained its status as a major contributor of energy education through informative programs, on-site field trips, seminars, and workshops.

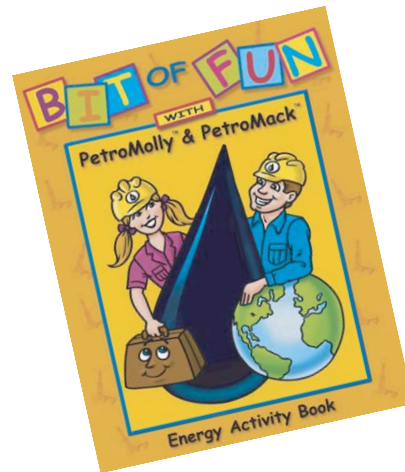
